



Hamaspik Medicare Select and Hamaspik Medicare Choice Monthly Plan Premium for People who get Extra Help from Medicare to Help Pay for their Prescription Drug Costs

If you get extra help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be lower than what it would be if you did not get extra help from Medicare.

If you get extra help, your monthly plan premium will be \$0 for any of the plan(s) below. (This does not include any Medicare Part B premium you may have to pay.) Please note that the following plans from Hamaspik Inc. have \$0 plan premiums:

- Hamaspik Medicare Select (HMO D-SNP)
- Hamaspik Medicare Choice (HMO D-SNP)

Hamaspik Medicare Select's and Hamaspik Medicare Choice's \$0 premium includes coverage for both medical services and prescription drug coverage.
